Note: In each case above the speaker cites Isaiah 6:9-10. Who is speaking? Who is he speaking to? Where did this occur? What was the culture? What was the situation?

- Isaiah 6:1-10; all of Chapter 55. Jesus fulfilled all
- Proverbs 3:13 thru 5:1; 8:1 thru 9:6; 18:13; 20:12 (and more)
- Revelation 2:7, 11, 17, 29; 3:6, 13, 20, 22; 13:9

Just wondering

God spoke to lots of people in the past: Men, women, children, prenatal infants, etc. in the Bible—both Testaments.

He even spoke to animals and plants and natural stuff.

We hear people say, "God said..."; "God spoke to me and..."; "God told me..."

Does God really speak to people still?

Has God ever communicated directly with you?

If so, how?

What was the outcome?

Some ways God spoke back then

- 1. Circumstances (Jonah)
- 2. Counsel (Proverbs, people, wise / trusted counsel)
- 3. Peace (Philippians 4:6-10, Colossians 3:15)
- 4. People (Acts 21:10-11)
- 5. Dreams & visions (Salomon-1st Kings 3; Peter-Acts 10; Joseph-Gen. 37-41, Matthew 1:20 John-Book of Revelation)

- 6. Thoughts (Paul, Jacob, Joseph)
- 7. Natural manifestations (1st Kings 19; many others) thunder, wind, flood, etc.
- 8. Supernatural manifestations(Balaam's donkey, Numbers 21 & 22; Philip, Acts 8:26-40, John 20)
- 9. Scripture (Romans 10:17)
- 10. Whisper (Elijah, 1st Kings 19)

10 ways our God speaks still

He's ever present. He's available. He's good.

- Scripture (Partner with Holy Spirit)
- · Holy Spirit
 - · Audibly
 - Nudge
 - Knowing
 - Peace
 - Discerning
- Physical senses
 - Sight
 - Sound
 - Smell
 - Taste
 - Touch
- Dreams, visions, trances

- · Thoughts unbidden
- People
 - Spouse
 - Family
 - Friend
 - · Teacher / preacher / presenter
 - Prophecy
 - · Word of knowledge, word of wisdom
- Signs and semiotics
- Circumstances
- Patterns
- Creation: Nature, art, music, design

Source: self, satan or Spirit?

Is it me? Is it false prophecy? Is it authentic prophecy?

- 1. Test the thought's origin
 - Did it come from self or other? Chain, train, tangential? Or spontaneous?
 - If other (spontaneous): Did it bubble up or boil up?
- 2. Test against baselines and plumblines
 - Compare to scripture, biblical principles, Kingdom dynamics
 - Compare to biblical names of God and character of God
- 3. What's the fruit and fuel within? What was birthed, what was fed?
 - Faith? Love? Peace? Joy? Humility? Vitality? Vigor?
 - Confusion? Anxiety? Fear? Doubt? Ego/self-promotion? Ugh? Retreat?
- 4. Test with spiritual counselors or trustworthy others
