




Philippians 2:9-12, KJV



Calls to action: Accept challenge

- Rethink "sinner's prayer". "... contrary to man's perspective, the Lord is not late with
 His promise to return, as some measure lateness. But rather, his "delay" simply
 reveals his loving patience toward you [all people], because He does not want any to
 perish but all to come to repentance."
 - ~ Apostle Peter, 2nd Peter 3:8-9 " Those verses do not refer to sin, in any direct sense.
- Rethink the fundamental question. Is it truly, "Am I going to Heaven?"
- Or is it more like, "In my very essence am I with Christ and in Christ now? Believing, trusting, obeying, following, transforming? IOW: Am I inwardly proclaiming and expressing the Kingdom of God (the manifest ruling presence God)? Am I outwardly expressing and demonstrating the manifest ruling presence of God?"
- How closely do my thoughts, words and lifestyle choices resemble Matthew 5-7?
 (And if even a whiff of guilt, condemnation or shame arise, that's a key indicator)
