

Guidelines & Keys

- . Most important of all: PARTNER WITH HOLY SPIRIT. He is eager to do so
- · Every scripture is for the church but not every scripture is to the church
- Context is EVERYTHING
 - · Be wary of proof-texting by yourself or others
 - · Who is speaking?
 - · What is their role, position or title?
 - · Who is he/she/they speaking to (audience, person, group)?
 - . What is the situation (location, timeframe, setting, concern, issue, etc.)?
- Study bibles are good... for studying (getting context, satisfying curiosity)
- Read ABOVE the black line most of the time. Ignore breaks & headings?
- The Godhead (Trinity) is understandable (contrary to common opinion)

Unearthing bible treasure; pulling on deep wells

- · Pray before, during and after reading
- · Engage Holy Spirit, literally, aloud
- Go at your own pace, unpressured
 - Read and digest in manageable bites
 - Slow and well digested is better than fast or "goal achieved"
- · Find, dedicate, fix up, keep up favorite places to read / listen
- · Start wherever you want, read in whatever order you want or are led
 - · Be choosy, get personal about what structure or plan to use, if any
- Mark up your bible; use a journal; hand write
 - Using bible tabs it NOT cheating, does NOT make you "less than"
 - · Write in it, highlight passages, etc.
 - · Touch your bible and your journal. Feel them, be tactile

Unearthing bible treasure; pulling on deep wells

- · Choose topics or characters interesting or relevant to you
- · Look up what you don't understand. It's super easy to do nowadays
- · Read aloud, whenever and wherever you can
- · Read or share with others
 - · Discuss, argue with others (honorably, with love)
- · Journal what you learn. Writing by hand is best practice
- · Journal your questions
- · Especially, note and write down things you sense
 - · See, hear, feel, smell, taste
- Most of all, "How is Jesus revealed?" Anew, more deeply, etc.

Call to Action

- Decide/surrender: "I want to know God more deeply. I want to read the bible"
- Ask Holy Spirit: Please help me.
 And where is a good setting for me to call special for bible reading and listening
- Come get a bible, notebook, pen if you need to or want to
- Start. Just start. (Book of John?)
