- Highly accurate and most current (in JP's opinion): ESV, NRSV, NIV
- · Very good, accurate, easier to read: NLT, CEV, GWT
- Great alternatives, interpretive, helpful: MSG, TPT
- Also common among churches, denominations and teachers: NKJV, KJV, AMP
- Recommended digital resources: YouVersion, Bible Gateway (especially subscriber version), Logos software, Wikipedia (for now...)
- What bible translation do we recommend most highly?
 Whichever one in which you are fully engaged at any given time!

- 9. Listen.




Just do it...

Just do it...

- Your way is fine
- With Holy Spirit, build your own personal practice







Suggested, DO:

- Establish appointed time(s) and place(s) to engage with scripture
- Establish a practice & dedicate a method to record as you engage
 - You will likely find handwriting in a journal or notebook best, over time
- Pray, thank, praise, open yourself to receive
- · Invite Holy Spirit to join, guide, lead, speak, teach
- Just read. Study is good too but it's a different thing
 - Commentaries are not gospel. OK to ignore headings, and breaks in chapter and verse numbers
- Engage with care. Slow is better; chew thoroughly
- Remember, questions are more important than answers
 - You're trying to RENEW your mind, not fill up or satisfy your current one
- Set as your background key questions (see later slide)

All-important, ever-present quest of discovery

Lifelong, overarching, constant:

- What is God REALLY like (His character, nature, etc.)?
- · What does God REALLY think of me?

For bible engagement:

- How do these verses reveal, illuminate, clarify, amplify Jesus?
- What is the story here?
- Why is it important?
- What is my part?
