John 8:12 Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

John 1:5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

John 1:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

John 1:14, TPT And so the Living Expression became a man and lived among us! We gazed upon his glory [*light and power that radiates*], the glory of the One and Only who came from the Father overflowing with tender mercy and truth!

Psalms 119:105 Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

Psalms 97:11 Light is sown for the righteous, and joy for the upright in heart.

Matthew 17:2 And he was transfigured before them, and his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became white as light.
